BUY the iShares Silver Trust (SLV) June 2026 \$60-\$65 vertical BULL CALL debit spread at \$4.40 or best

Opening Trade

Supply chain kinks for the AI build-out are getting extreme, and none is worse than for silver.

Silver suffered its worst meltdown in market history in January. Some five months later, that disaster has been digested. New all-time highs for silver beckon.

This also qualifies as a trade that profit-takers from the top-performing AI names will roll into.

Therefore, I am buying the **iShares Silver Trust (SLV) June 2026 \$60-\$65 vertical BULL CALL debit spread at \$4.40 or best.**

Don't pay more than \$4.70, or you will be chasing.

If you don't want to sit in front of a screen all day or live in a foreign time zone when the US stock market is closed, such as Australia, or don't want to sit in front of a screen all day, simply enter a spread of **Good-Until-Cancelled** orders overnight, like \$4.40, \$4.45, \$4.50, \$4.55, \$4.60, \$4.65, and \$4.70. You should get done on some or all of these.

The iShares Silver Trust (SLV) is a play on physical silver.

Silver is an investment much like other precious metals. It has been regarded as a form of money and a store of value for more than 4,000 years. You can find silver relics that the Pharaohs used in Egypt's National Museum at the foot of the Great Pyramid.

Silver lost its role as legal tender in developed countries when the use of the silver standard came to an end in 1935. Some countries still mint silver coins and collector coins, such as the American Silver Eagle with nominal face values. The main demand for silver was for industrial applications (40%), jewelry, bullion, and ETFs. Global silver reserves amounted to 610,000 metric tonnes at the end of 2023.

The (SLV) is part of the BlackRock family of ETFs, with \$10.6 billion in assets under management, and an expense ratio of 0.50%. It is priced off the open market for silver bullion traded on the LBMA, or the London Bullion Metals Exchange. The silver is held in the exchange vaults in London. The world's largest banks are the market makers in the LBMA, including:

Goldman Sachs International.

HSBC Bank Plc.

JP Morgan Chase Bank.

UBS AG.

Morgan Stanley & Co International Plc.

The LBMA headquarters are next door to the Bank of England and down the street

from my old office at Morgan Stanley in the City of London. LMBA holds 25,612 metric tonnes of silver, valued at \$20.2 billion, which equates to approximately 823,451 silver bars. For more information about the LBMA, visit their website [here](#).

This is a bet that the (SLV) will not fall below \$65 by the June option expiration in 25 trading days.

Here are the specific trades you need to execute this position:

Buy 25 June 2026 (SLV) \$60 calls at.....\$21.00
Sell short 25 June 2026 (SLV) \$65 calls at.....\$16.60
Net Cost:.....\$4.40

Potential Profit: \$5.00 - \$4.40 = \$0.60

(25 X 100 X \$0.60) = \$1,500 or 13.64% in 25 trading days.

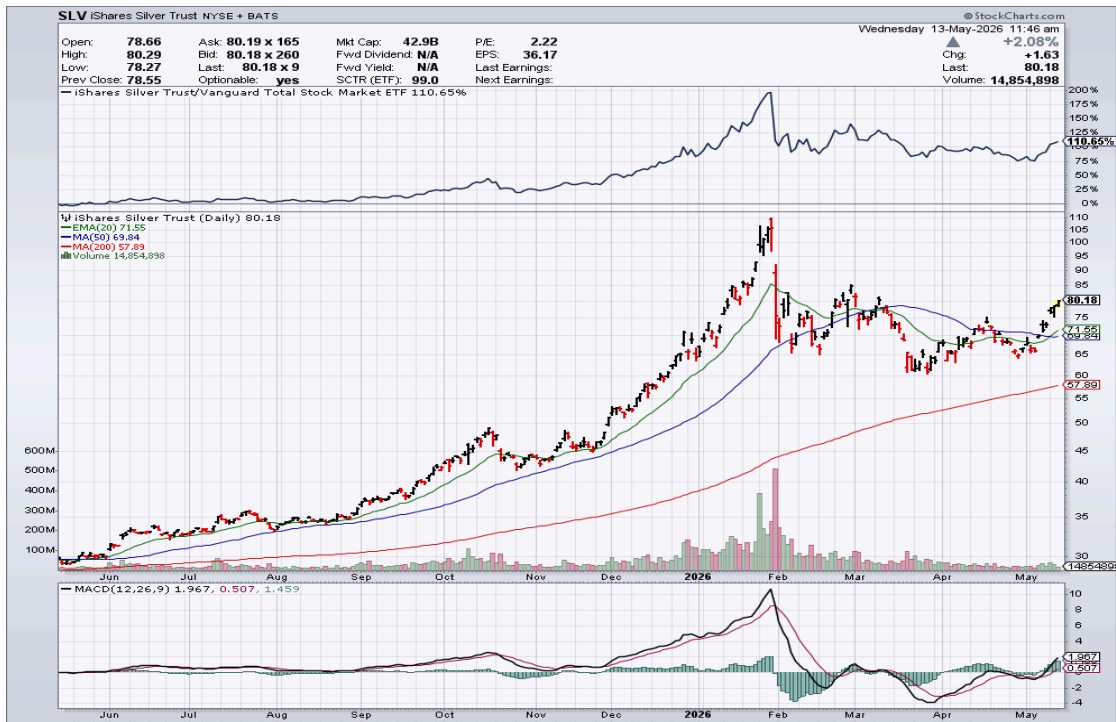
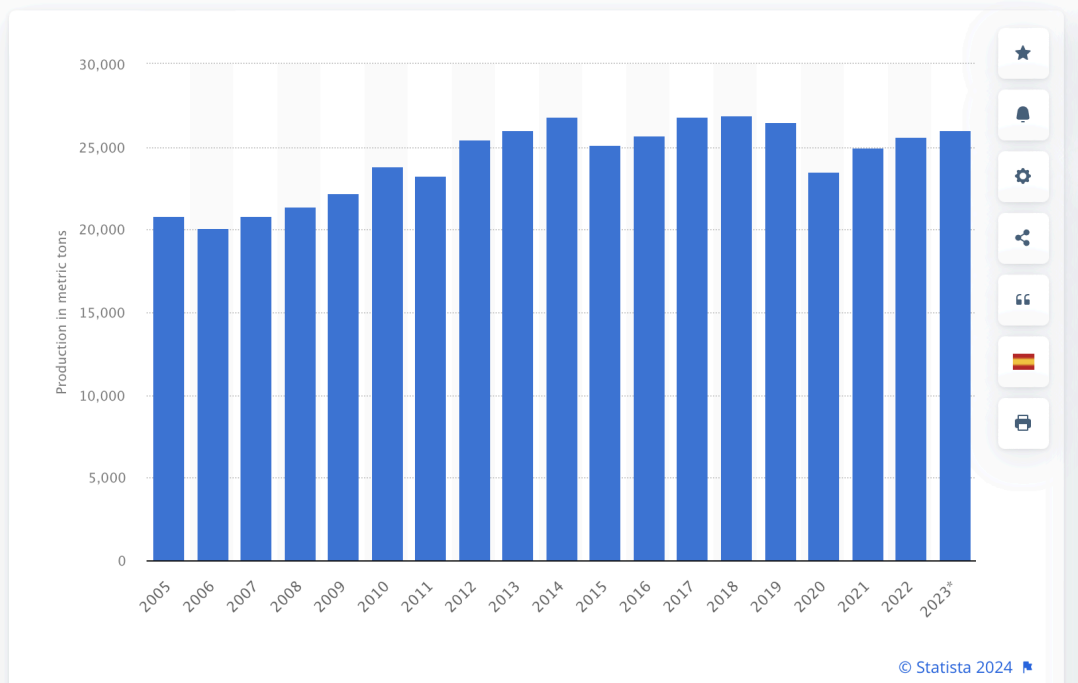

The best execution can be had by placing your bid for the entire spread in the middle market and waiting for the market to come to you. The difference between the bid and the offer on these deep in-the-money spread trades can be enormous.

Don't execute the legs individually, or you will end up losing much of your profit. Spread pricing can be very volatile on expiration months farther out.

Keep in mind that these are ballpark prices at best. After the alerts go out, prices can be all over the map.
